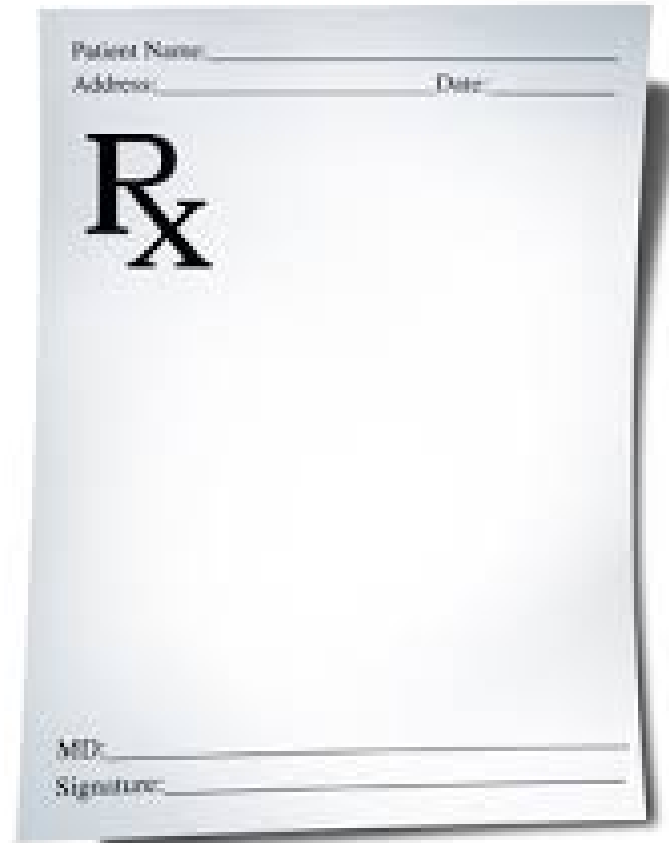
Silos, Superheros, or Sharing....





Difficult conversations

- What does a prescription mean?
- Who is part of the team?
 - Physician
 - Nurse
 - Physical Therapy
 - Pharmacist
 - Patient
 - Family Members





What do we document?

- Do we document the conversation?
 - Risks
 - Overdose Risk
 - Addiction Risk Assessment
 - Proper Disposal
 - Realistic Benefit
 - Other options for treatment that were explained





What do we give the patient?

- Where is the focus of the appointment – diagnosis or education?
- Do they need to leave with a prescription?
- Should there be more than the Prescription?
- Informed Consent
- Shared Understanding





What do we share with Colleagues?

- If a prescription for opioids is written?
 - What should be given to other collaborators?
 - Is the PDMP a crutch?
 - Is the EHR a crutch?
- What is the patient's responsibility?
